




Training Schedule – Competition Venue

Training at the competition venue will take place from the 24 to the 26 March from 10:00 to 13:00.

8. PARTICIPANTS

Entries will be accepted only from National World Aquatics Member Federations which must also register a team official for each respective competitor. A team official can be responsible for up to two (2) competitors only. The team official is responsible for representing their competitor(s) at the Team Leaders Meeting, and feeding the competitor during the event(s). **A competitor without a coach present will not be allowed to start the race** unless World Aquatics has been previously informed.

9. ENTRY PROCESS

All National Federation registrations and sport entries must be done through the World Aquatics General Management System (GMS) via <https://data.worldaquatics.com/>. Each National Federation must complete their registrations before the designated deadlines.

10. TEAM LEADERS MEETING

The Team Leaders Meeting will take place on **Thursday, 26 March at 17:00 at The Cascades Hotel**. At least one representative from each National Federation must attend this meeting.

11. VENUE & COURSE INFORMATION

The main competition venue will be at the Somabay's Marina, Hurghada.



Course Information

The Men and Women 10km events will be organised on a 1,66km course, competitors will have to complete 6 laps.

The Mixed 4x1500 relay event will be organised in the same course as the 10km but a shorter lap of 1500m.

Exact venue layout and competition courses will be shared closer to the competition date.

12. RULES

Please note that all the events in the World Cup will be conducted according to latest World Aquatics Competition Regulations, in force at the time event.

13. ACCREDITATIONS & EVENT INFORMATION DESK

Accreditation

The Local Organising Committee will provide all competitors and Team Staff with an official Accreditation. Only accredited people will be allowed to access certain venue areas. All accredited people are requested to always carry their Accreditation with them and to show them upon request.

Accreditation can be collected at the Information Desk in the official hotel. Team Officials will be required to present photographic identification for all team members.

Information Desk

The official hotel will have an Information Desk where all the information related to the competition will be provided.

15. MEDICAL

All Medical Support will be delivered by the local health authorities and in articulation with the World Aquatics Medical and Safety Officers, as well as World Aquatics Rules and Procedures.

16. VISA INFORMATION & TRANSPORTATION

Visa Information

The Local Organising Committee will assist approved participating teams and their delegations by issuing visa invitation letters required for the visa application process and that are registered by the **27th of February 2026**. However, Mindset and the LOC do not provide any guarantee or assurance that a visa will be granted. The decision to approve or reject any visa application lies solely with the relevant embassy or immigration authorities. All participants remain fully responsible for submitting their applications on time and complying with the immigration requirements of the host country.

Transportation

- The Official Airport is the Hurghada International Airport. Pick-up and drop-off will be available from the airport to hotel. Cairo Airport transportation may be an option, but this must be individually agreed and fixed with the OC.

IMPORTANT: Rooms at The Kaktus Hotel will be allocated by the OC on a first-come, first-served basis. If the official hotel reaches full capacity, the OC will secure accommodation at an alternative hotel of the same category and price range.

18. CANCELLATION POLICY

Any cancellation after registration deadline of 27 February 2026 will be subject to pay full amount.

Any new bookings received after registration deadline 27 February 2026 will be subject to availability and 50% extra fee of charge

19. ANTI-DOPING

Urine and blood samples will be collected during the competition for the purpose of doping controls. The doping controls will be done in accordance with the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules and the World Anti-Doping International Standards, which can be consulted [here](#). The operations will be supervised and coordinated by the International Testing Agency (ITA).

The list of prohibited substances can be consulted [here](#). For reminder, all athletes are strictly responsible for any prohibited substance found in their sample and it is particularly important for them to check any medication they take against the prohibited list. Additionally, all athlete support personnel are responsible to be knowledgeable about anti-doping regulations and procedures.

Mandatory Anti-Doping education course prior to participation:

Athlete

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, any athlete participating in World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course "[International-Level Athletes Education Program](#)" or a course developed by their respective NADO and recognised by the AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit).* Any athlete who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to compete and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

Team Official: Coach, Head Coach, Chef de Mission, Team Leader, or Support Staff

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, anyone registered as a team official—including coach, head coach, chef de mission, team leader, support staff—for World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course "[Coaches of High Performance Education Program](#)" or a course developed by their respective NADO and recognised by the AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit).* Anyone who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to participate and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

Team Official: Doctor, Medical Professional, Massage Therapist, or Physiotherapist

As per the World Aquatics Doping Control Rules, anyone registered as a team official—including doctor, medical professional, massage therapist, physiotherapist—for World Aquatics Events must, prior to participation, have successfully completed the eLearning Anti-Doping Education course "[ADEL for Medical Professional's Education Program](#)" or a course developed by their respective NADO and recognised by the AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit).* Anyone who has not met this requirement will not be eligible to participate and thus will not have their accreditation activated.

*** AQIU (Aquatics Integrity Unit) Recognised NADO Education Programs**

Please refer to the list of anti-doping education programs from National Anti-Doping Organisations (NADOs) whose certifications are recognised by the AQIU [here](#). These certifications will be accepted as fulfilling the mandatory anti-doping education requirements for all World Aquatics competitions.

Steps to Complete the ADEL Certification

Please follow these instructions in order to complete the ADEL course:

Step 1:

Access the eLearning course webpage [here](#).

Step 2:

Click on “Register here” and follow the steps to register an account.

Step 3:

Sign in to the new account just created.

Step 4:


Based on the category, select the course **“International-Level Athletes Education Program”**, **“Coaches of High-Performance Education Program”** or **“ADEL for Medical Professional’s Education Program”** and complete the course to obtain at least 80% at the final exam at the end of the course. You can do the course again if you do not achieve 80% the first time. The athletes’ course is available in twenty-three languages, the coaches’ course in seventeen languages, and the medical professionals’ course is offered in three languages. Each course takes up to 2-3 hours to complete. The courses can also be accessed through the **“ADEL by WADA”** mobile application.

Step 5:

Once the course has been successfully completed, download the certificate of completion, and send it to your World Aquatics Member. The ADEL guidelines to download the certificate can be found [here](#). Step 6:

The World Aquatics Member must upload the certificate of completion of each athlete on their respective GMS profile [here](#) (in the Sport tab).


Athletes and team officials are encouraged to renew their certifications every four years to stay up to date with the latest anti-doping regulations and procedures.
